SAN LUIS

San Luis is part of the Nuevo Cuyo Region and is strategically located in the geographical centre of the Bioceanic Corridor that links the ports of Buenos Aires (Argentina) and Valparaíso (Chile).

Our territory, inhabited by various indigenous nations: Huarpes, Diaguitas, Comechingones, saw the arrival of the Spanish conqueror in the 16th century. The first province as a Cabildo city to adhere to the Revolutionary movement of May 1810.

In recent years, we have experienced a strong process of productive reconfiguration linked to the development of industrial activity, of which we are very proud.

TOURISM

The province of San Luis stands out for the diversity of its landscapes, natural and cultural attractions, infrastructure works and a full annual agenda of recreational activities, art, shows and sports. It has around 36,000 hotel beds and is characterised by its tourism offer based on sierras, rivers and dams, with eight tourist areas. These are: Sierras Centrales. This is the most traditional of the province's circuits, located in the foothills of the eastern slopes of the Sierras de San Luis. Its destinations and attractions are appreciated by tourists and locals alike, who seek out its streams and dams. It is made up of Juana Koslay, Potrero de los Funes, El Volcán, El Trapiche, La Florida, Estancia Grande, Valle de Pancanta, La Carolina, Paso del Rey and the City of San Luis as distribution centre.

The Comechingones Coast. This corridor is located on the western side of the Sierras de Los Comechingones, in the northeast extreme of San Luis. The interest of the area lies in the microclimate of Villa de Merlo as the main destination for provincial and national tourism with its wide range of hotels, gastronomy and services for excursions and related activities. To the south of the tourist locality and following the Provincial Route No 1, we find Carpintería, Los Molles, Cortaderas, Villa Larca, Papagayos, Villa del Carmen and La Punilla, each one of them with its natural charms, waterfalls, dams and activities.

Northern Puntano. It starts in the City of San Luis and extends towards the north following the western slope of the Sierras de San Luis, among dams, rivers and high mountain roads. It is formed by the City of La Punta, Villa de La Quebrada, Nogolí, Villa General Roca, San Francisco del Monte de Oro, Leandro Alem, Luján, Candelaria y Lafinur.

















Conlara Valley and San Martin. Between the Sierras de San Luis and the Sierras de Los Comechingones, in the northeast of the province, is located this wide valley crossed by the Conlara River, whose course runs from south to north. It is the environment to visit spas and dams, to go on trips to mining towns and to visit protected areas, museums and old chapels.

The department of San Martin, with its picturesque mountain villages, stands out for its stories of malones and pioneers, mineral wealth and traditional architectural heritage. Destinations: Naschel, Tilisarao, Renca, Concarán, Santa Rosa del Conlara, Bajo de Véliz, San Martín and Las Chacras. Villa Mercedes and El Morro. Between mountains and plains, the region combines natural attractions, urban expressions and rural culture. Villa Mercedes, the second city in provincial importance, is identified by the Calle Angosta, the Quinto River and the Parque La Pedrera, an unprecedented sports and cultural mega project. The town of San José del Morro is pure history, in an enchanting environment whose main protagonist is its hill, born in remote volcanic times. La Toma, Capital of Marble Onyx offers mining experiences where you can learn about the origin and applications of the green veined onyx, a mineral pride of La Toma.

Traces of the Past. The area is located in the northwest sector of the territory of San Luis. The Sierras de Las Quijadas National Park is a natural scenery of singular rock formations of reddish tonality moulded by erosion. It treasures dinosaur fossil remains, geological records and archaeological sites of native cultures. In the lands of Guanacache, inhabits the Huarpe community (developed from the actions of the Government of San Luis) that maintains its cosmovision and customs, while La Calera is known for the extraction of flimestone stones on a large scale.

Hot Springs and Salt Lakes. A few kilometres away from the City of San Luis are Balde and San Jeronimo, two centres of thermal waters recommended for their therapeutic benefits. The Salinas del Bebedero salt pans, make up an immense white landscape that shows all its splendour in the winter when great extensions of salt accumulate.

Southern plains. The geography of the south of the province is integrated with its nature of unlimited horizons, sand dunes, pastures and more than 170 water mirrors, where pejerrey fishing takes place. In this context we find the Ranquel Nation People, a community that was established after the restitution of their lands by the Government of San Luis.

















CLIMATE

It is generally dry continental with an average annual temperature of 17 °C, an average winter temperature of 8 °C and a summer temperature of 24 °C. Rainfall decreases from east to west and falls mainly in summer, between October and March. In winter, it is almost non-existent and may fall as snow at any altitude, but especially in the sierras above 1000 m sl.

In the mountainous area, the biome is arid of sierras and fields, although on the eastern slopes of the sierras there is a temperate biome, which is more humid than the previous one, since the foothills of the sierras act as a condensation front for the Atlantic wind.

In the Conlara Valley area there is a very special microclimate, characterised by the high natural negative ionisation of the air, with a high ozone content that has very beneficial effects on health.

INTERNATIONAL TIME

In the whole of Argentina, including San Luis, the time is set according to Greenwich Mean Time. The difference is -4 hours.

CURRENCY

Peso Argentino.

ELECTRICITY

Electrical sockets are of European type with inputs for two round pins or 3 flat pins.









VISA

Countries belonging to Atletismo Sudamericano do not require visa to enter Argentina.

COMMUNICATION

San Luis offers a wide range of national and international communication possibilities for data, voice and image transmission. Both hotels and cafes offer internet service.



All implements must comply with World Athletics Technical Rules.

Medical & Emergency Services

The venue will be equipped with emergency medical services including a medical evacuation system.

The organisers will require international medical insurance for all participants.

PARTICIPATION

General Rules

South American U18 Championship will be in accordance with Official World Athletics (WA hereinafter) Rules, and Atletismo Sudamericano (A.S., hereinafter) Regulations. Cases not foreseen will be resolved by the Technical Delegate and the Competition Director.

Safeguarding Activities

In accordance with the W.A. and A.S. Safeguarding Rules and the recent WA decision at the U-20 World Championships in Lima 2024, A.S. established that all teams must have a Safeguarding Officer within its official members. This must be officially communicated to the A.S. Safeguarding Officer

A special session on Safeguarding dedicated to all athletes will be held on **Friday 6th** at 11.00 a.m. at a venue to be designated near the teams' accommodation.

Participants

Athletes from all countries affiliated to Atletismo Sudamericano and World Athletics, who meet the following requirements, may participate in this event:

- Be born in the country they represent or be naturalised in the same country, residing in the same country for - at least - five years.
- Be duly registered with the National Federation of his/her country
- **1** To be duly entered in the competition through his/her National Federation.

Each team must submit the passport of each athlete or any other official document indicating the date of birth as evidence of their age.

For each entered athlete the Local Organising Committee has to photocopy the submitted document as evidence.

AGE CATEGORY

This event is aimed at the U18 category. Accordingly, and taking into account the limitations that emanate from W.A. competition rules and the relevant A.S. rules, the following may take part in the event:

- U18 Athletes: Any athlete aged 15, 16 or 17 by December 2024 (born in 2009, 2008 y 2007).
- Younger Athletes: No athlete younger than 15 years old by December 2024 (born in 2010 or later) may participate.

PARTICIPATION LIMIT

- ► Each country may enter a maximum of two (2) athletes per event and one team in each of the relays.
- ▶ Each athlete may participate up to a maximum of two (2) individual events and both relays.
- ▶ In individual races of more than 200 metres, they will only be allowed to participate in one individual race per day.
- Athletes entered in Combined Events can only participate in these events.

Preliminary Entries will be made by digital form **before Wednesday 30 October 2024 at 24.00 hs**, according to Buenos Aires time zone (GMT-4).

CONFIRMATION

The Team Leader or Official Representative must confirm in writing on special organization forms the list of entered athletes who will participate in each event, **before 12:00 pm the day before the event** at the Technical Information Centre.

Confirmation for the first day must be made at the relevant Technical Meeting.

Only athletes who are duly entered in the corresponding events as indicated in the previous point (final registrations) will be able to be confirmed.

This is to avoid the inclusion of athletes in qualifying events who, despite being entered, do not participate later.

The withdrawal/confirmation forms will be distributed to the team leaders at the technical meeting.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TECHNICAL INFORMATION CENTRE - TIC.

Located next to the main entrance of the stadium, near the first curve, it will be the place where delegates must confirm athletes' participation, collect bulletins, results, submit protests, request information about competitions, transport, official communications and competition development and present throwing implements to be checked.

INFORMATION FOR TEAM LEADERS

ARRIVAL

The Organising Committee will provide an information desk at the Official Airport for teams' reception and transfer to the accreditation and accommodation venues.

ACCOMMODATION

The organisation will cover full accommodation from Thursday 5th December until Monday 9th December for a maximum of seventy (70) athletes and twelve (12) officials in accordance with Atletismo Sudamericano's regulations. Those teams that, due to inconvenient connections, need to extend their arrival or departure days, must request the consideration and authorisation of the Organising Committee.

Team Leaders should announce well in advance the number of accompanying persons who do not comply with the above to ensure availability of accommodation. The costs of these additional groups shall be borne by the respective teams.

Extra days of stay of any person as part of the team (including athletes), which are not within the days established by the organisation, will be cancelled before the accreditation process.

Team Assistants

The Organising Committee will provide teams with a guide service to assist them during their stay in the City.

Participants' Numbers - Bibs

Each athlete will receive four (4) numbers which will be distributed at the technical meeting: two (2) for the T-shirt (one on the chest and one on the back), one (1) for the warm-up uniform and one (1) for the bag.

Only in jumps athletes may wear only one bib number (either on the back or on the chest).

















Bibs may not be folded, cut or modified for any reason, in accordance with WA regulations, on pain of disqualification of the athlete.

Athletes participating in running events will be provided with two (2) numbers to be worn on each side of the shorts or trousers at the Call Room, before entering the track.

Athletes Uniforms

Athletes must wear the official uniform of their country, which must conform to WA rules.

The Awards Ceremony is part of the competition and will be held immediately after the end of each event. Athletes must wear the official uniform of their country during this Ceremony.

Official Results

The official results of each event will be announced by the official announcing system in Spanish.

The results will be considered official from the moment they are read out by the official announcer.

A copy of the results of each event will be published in the TIC. In addition, they will be available in resultadosonline.ar of Atletismo Sudamericano and the Confederación Argentina de Atletismo.

















TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Track Events

Qualification rounds will be arranged by the Technical Secretariat under the supervision and approval of Atletismo Sudamericano Technical Delegate, taking into consideration athletes' best performances obtained during the previous 12 months and which appear in the official ranking of Atletismo Sudamericano.

RACE WALK

A **penalty zone** will be established. Athletes who received three disqualification orders will be required to enter the penalty zone for the following times:

• 5000 m WOMEN: 0,5 minute

10000 m MEN: 1 minute

In the event that this time is not applicable (because the athlete is arriving at the finish line), this time will be added to his/her performance at the end of the race.

Upon receipt of the fourth disqualification request, they will be disqualified from the event and will have to leave the course and remove their bibs.

Hydration. As established in the WA technical rules, if necessary due to weather conditions, the Technical Delegate may arrange for hydration/sponges to be provided by the organisation. If this is the case, it will be placed in the area of the opposite straight.

RELAY EVENTS

Relay teams shall be registered by means of the corresponding forms to be presented at the TIC up to three hours before the start of each of the relay events.

The composition of a team and the order of running for a relay shall be officially declared no later than the published call time (the time by which the athletes must be present in the Call Room).

In the case of mixed 8x300 relays, they shall follow the order standardised by WA for this type of

event: male - female - male - female - male - female - male - female - male - female.

PROTESTS

Any claim must be made verbally first to the Event's Referee by the athlete himself/herself or by his/her delegate immediately.

Appeals related to results must be submitted in writing on forms provided by the Organization, signed by the official delegate on behalf of the athlete, no more than 30 minutes after the results have been officially announced, accompanying the appeal with a US\$100 deposit.

All appeals must be handed to the person in charge of the Technical Information Centre. The person presenting an appeal shall receive a copy containing the time of receipt.

In this case, the jury of appeal, a collegiate body, shall be convened and shall reply n writing and after examining all available evidence as soon as possible.

INFORMATION FOR ATHLETES

Sport Equipment

The organisation will provide athletes with official equipment in accordance with the WA Rules for all the events to take place in the Championship. Personal implements will be permitted provided that they are presented to the Technical Director to be checked via the TIC one (1) day before the start of the event.

Poles Control

Poles must be presented to the Technical Direction two (2) hours before the start of the event.

Training Schedules

Training sessions will be programmed by the organisation, with team leaders according to needs and availability, the schedules will be announced during the technical meeting.

Call Room

Only one Call Room will be used located next to the warm-up track, compulsory for all athletes. Combined events athletes must only report before the first event of each day

The following controls will be carried out in the Call Room:

- Athletes identification and position in the start lists
- ▶ Bibs control
- Control of Official Uniforms
- ► Control and eventual removal of unauthorised material
- Control of competition material in accordance with WA, i.e.

















• Shoes with special reference to the WA Technical Rule n° 5, remembering that it is the responsibility of each athlete to ensure that their footwear is in accordance with the relevant competition group according to the previous control to be carried out in the official application

https://certcheck.worldathletics.org. There they must insert brand and model, the system will show a picture of it and the group of events for which the footwear is approved. Everything that is not approved is forbidden for use, and may have effects -even- once the event is over. It is reiterated that he athlete is responsible for this control.

Number and dimension of spikes— no shoes with spikes longer than **6 mm** will be allowed, except in the high jump and javelin events, where the limit will be **9 mm.** No 'needle' spikes will be allowed, only 'pyramid' or 'tree' spikes will be accepted.























No team leader or officials shall be allowed in the Call Room.

The entrance to the track, jumping or throwing areas is done in an orderly manner preceding he officials and protocol guide.

Relevant introductions will be made immediately before the start of each event. In throwing and horizontal events athletes eliminated at the end of the qualifying rounds (3rd) will leave the competition area accompanied by an official. Similarly, athletes who finish their participation in the vertical jumps will also leave the competition area.

At the end of the competitions, athletes will leave the area in line behind the officials.
